Teuta's quest for knowledge never stops. She is currently completing a diploma in aesthetic medicine and contributing to medical research in collaboration with Dr Dhillon



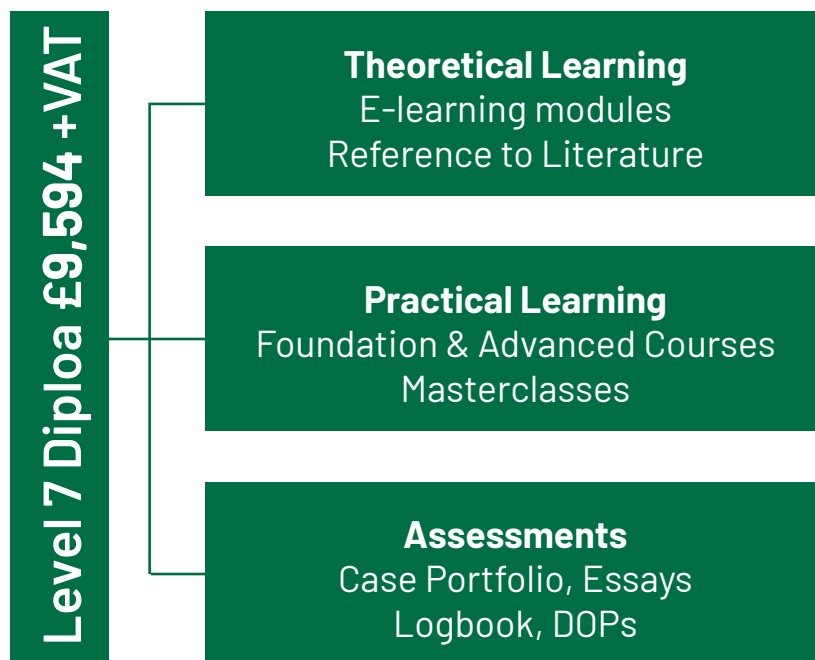
Dr Lee Walker

Why Choose Our Level 7 Diploma

Our highly experienced team provide a culture and environment of supportive learning to provide you with a postgraduate level of understanding and skills in delivering non-surgical facial aesthetics. The programme covers extensive theory and provides considerable hands-on practice with live models across six hands on days.

To accommodate for ever demanding work schedules and lifestyles we take a blended learning approach. This allows us to cover most of the theory through online learning modules with the hands-on days focussed on providing the practical skills and experience on live models to give you the confidence to treat patients in your own surgeries.

All hands-on days take place in state of the practices with small groups of delegates to ensure each of you has sufficient time with one of the clinical teaching team on the day. Each member of the clinical team will be assigned no more than five delegates on the day. All the very best materials and equipment you'll need are provided on the day too so you can work confidently knowing there are no compromises.

The end of the Diploma is not the end of your journey, and you'll have access to a Facebook group with your peers and the clinical team to give you a safe place to ask for help and support. All Diploma students will have access to discounted mentoring support if they want further to support or to practice more enhanced techniques.

How You'll be Assessed

The Diploma has several different assessment methods to help us ensure both your theory and practical skills are tested robustly. The number and variety of assessments is designed to ensure you leave the Diploma adequately equipped to treat your patients safely.

You will be tested using the following methods:

- 1) Face to Face supervised learning
- 2) E- Learning Assessments with MCQs
- 3) Journal review
- 4) Essay writing
- 5) Case discussions
- 6) Practical Portfolio
- 7) Case Presentation

Face to Face supervised learning

Participants will be assessed on each of the hands-on days by one of the teaching team using a scoring grid. The skills that will be tested will have been taught on the day or as part of the e-learning modules.



E-Learning Assessments with MCQs

Online learning modules will be accessible through our online learning portal.

The online learning forms a significant part of our Diploma, allowing you to learn the theory behind the practical skills at a pace that suits you around your lifestyle.

All the relevant modules must be fully completed with the MCQs passed before participants can progress to the next module.

Journal Review

Participants are required to keep themselves up to on relevant facial aesthetic papers. Participants will be set journal reviews where a journal will be shared with you. Delegates will be asked to summarise the paper in a set number of words. The participants will be assessed on critical reading, writing, and discussing the relevance of the paper in their daily practice. You will have thirty days to complete journal review.

Essay writing

Throughout the Diploma you will be set topic on which you will be asked to write 500 words essay. You will have thirty days to complete essay.

Practical Portfolio

Delegates will be required to complete 40 procedures both with botulinum toxin and dermal fillers and record in a logbook.

Each procedure will need to include:

- 1) History and presenting complaint
- 2) Consultation and record keeping
- 3) Consent
- 4) Summary of treatment carried out
- 5) Choice of products
- 6) Areas treated
- 7) Clinical outcome

Pricing Structure and Payment Plans

The Level 7 Diploma is priced at £9,594 +VAT and provides the best value for money in covering the eight modules, two of which are fully on-line. We do provide the modules as a standalone for those that want to attend a specific class and not participate in the Diploma.

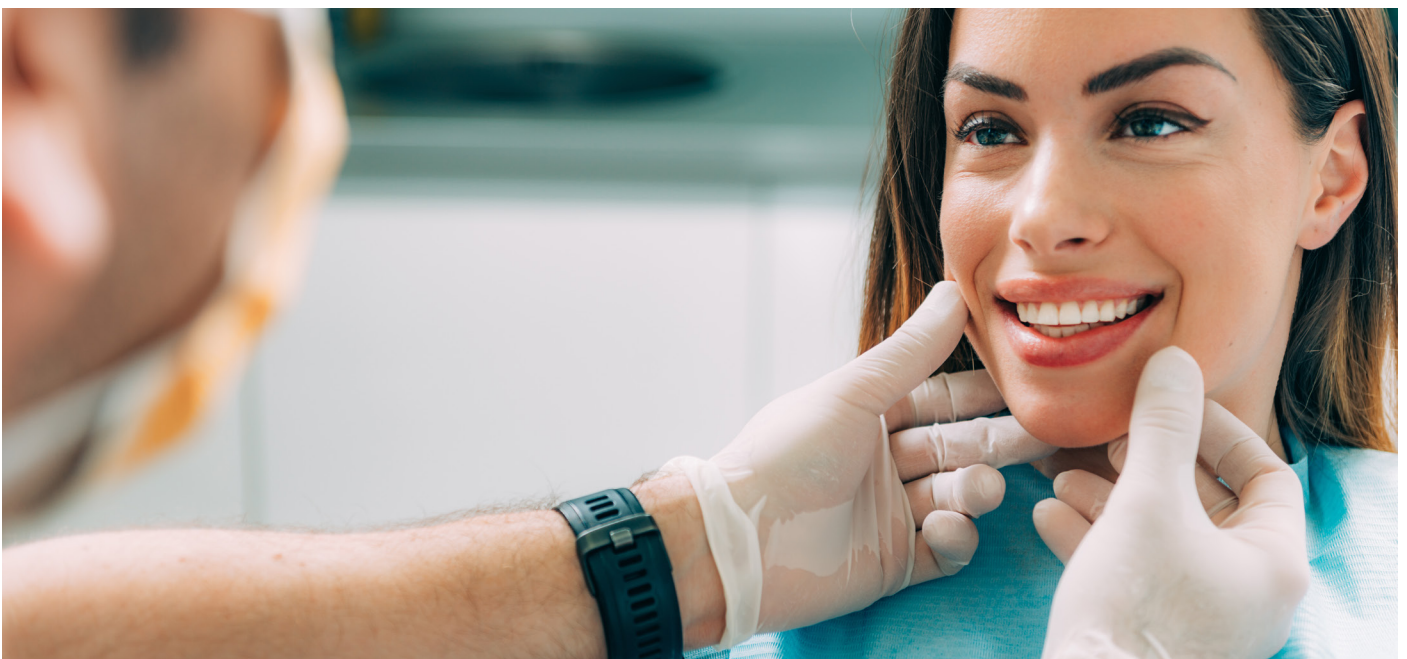

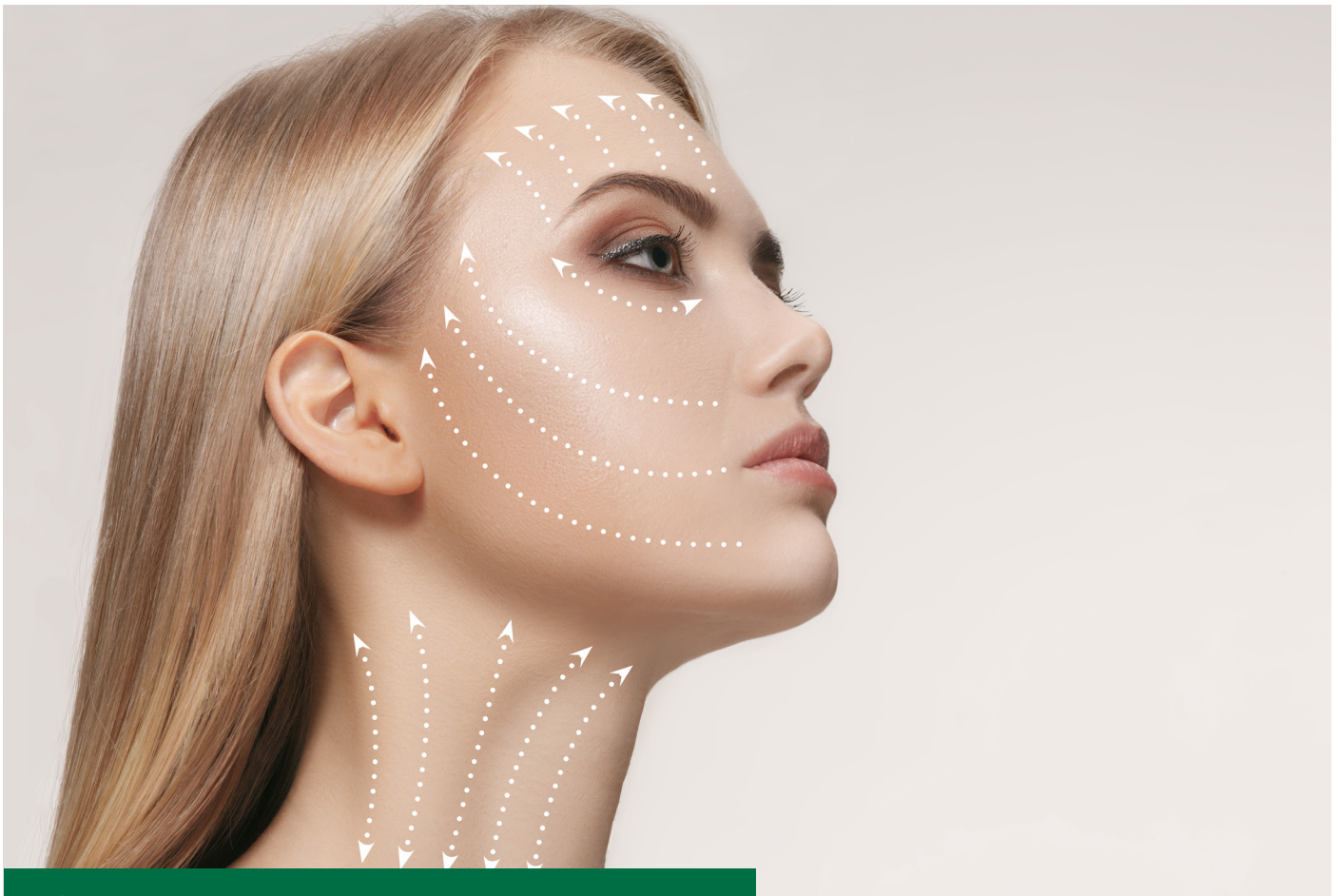
